

INVENTORY

In this inventory each separate entry in the manuscript is recorded, including all trope elements within the Proper trope repertory, but excepting short additions or alterations within a longer piece (such as a new verse for a prose). Orthography follows manuscript readings, although obvious errors have been corrected and noted. Abbreviations are silently expanded, and original majuscules/lower case replaced according to modern usage. Those situations in the manuscript where use of capitals is standard include rubrics, and the first lines of trope sets (see p. 4 above). Less standard is the use of capitals for the names of saints outside these situations, for example on fol. 43r, and the capitalization of just two Introids within the Tonary (fol. 72r). The inventory is set out in eight columns, as follows:

COLUMNS 1 AND 2 name the text and music scribes, according to the system of numbering set out in Chapter 6 above: scribes are given successive numbers as they appear, working through the manuscript from front to back. Where scribes continued work from one entry to the next, no new citation is made. Where work on one entry was shared, both scribes are noted in the appropriate column.

COLUMN 3 gives folio numbers. These are cited according to the beginning of the rubric for an entry, even where the rubric sits on a different page to the main body of the entry.

COLUMN 4 provides the full text of each rubric.

COLUMNS 5 AND 6 give the incipits of each entry. In the case of tropes the trope element appears in column 5, and the chant cue in column 6; in the case of proses, 'Alleluia' appears in column 5 (that is, when it appears in the manuscript) and the incipit of the prose that follows in column 6.

COLUMN 7 names the genre to which the entry belongs.

COLUMN 8 names the festal occasion for which the entry was intended. Where this information is not provided in the manuscript's rubrics but provided through comparison with another entry in the manuscript or with Bodley 775, it is shown in square brackets. Where the entry might be linked with more than one feast, this column is left blank.

Horizontal lines divide passages of material, for example, groups of tropes for different feasts, or types of *organa* (Sequences, Alleluias etc.), or separate groups of material added by different scribes. These are primarily intended to guide the eye, and do not necessarily indicate layers of material. Finally a series of signs provides further information about the entries:
